The Community Volunteer Program is a city service that is provided through our Neighborhood Partnership Office. In the ten years since the program was created, more than 18,500 volunteers have contributed nearly 71,000 volunteer hours which are valued at more than \$805,000.

Community volunteer projects are designed for large groups of volunteers. The average size of a group is about 25. So gather your friends, relatives or co-workers and become involved in the community. Individual volunteers are welcome to contact the office about volunteer opportunities and join a group to help out in the community.

Individuals or groups who are interested in volunteering should register with Glendale's Community Volunteer Program. Once you or your group registers with the city, you will be entered into a database and begin receiving a quarterly Volunteer E-Newsletter of upcoming projects.
