

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

January 2012



67TH AVENUE STORM DRAIN PROJECT (Frier Drive to Orangewood Avenue)

Construction is underway on the 67th Avenue Storm Drain Project between Frier Drive and Orangewood Avenue – which will help accommodate future stormwater flows in this area. Construction of the project began in late December 2011 and is expected to be completed in March 2012, barring any weather delays or unforeseen conditions.

During this work, traffic will be restricted to one lane in each direction on 67th Avenue with left turns and u-turns restricted near the construction activity. Traffic lanes will be shifted in various configurations around the work zone as construction progresses (e.g., northbound/southbound traffic moved to the outside lanes, inside lanes or moved to one side of the roadway). There may be brief periods where traffic will need to be stopped to move large construction equipment from one side of the road to the other.

The work is being conducted in three phases:

PHASE 1 (CURRENT PHASE)

Trenching and installing a new storm drain pipe in the center of 67th Avenue – working from south to north. Three new manholes will also be installed.

WORK ZONE: Center of the roadway.

DURATION: December 2011 – mid-February 2012

PHASE 2

Installing new catch basins and lateral feeder lines to tie the new storm drain into the existing storm drain system

WORK ZONE: Outside edges of the roadway and crossing over from the roadway edge to the center

DURATION: Mid-February 2012 – early March 2012

PHASE 3

Milling (removing the old pavement), paving and striping 67th Avenue between Orangewood Drive and Belmont Avenue

WORK ZONE: Will vary. The contractor will mill and pave one lane at a time throughout the roadway.

DURATION: Early to mid-March 2012

During much of the work, left turns entering and exiting driveways along 67th Avenue will be restricted. While left turn restrictions are in place, it is suggested that drivers wishing to access properties along 67th Avenue use the following alternate routes to allow for right turns into the driveway: northbound 67th Avenue from Glendale Avenue or southbound 67th Avenue from Northern or Grand avenues.

WORK HOURS: Contractor crews will be working from approximately 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. weekdays, with weekend construction as necessary.
