That is why the Airman's Attic at Luke Air Force Base is so important to airmen who are just starting out.

The Airman's Attic is an on-base emporium that gives away donated goods to junior service people at Luke Air Force Base. The store is run by volunteers and is open every Tuesday and Thursday from 10:00 AM to 1:00 PM and on the first and third Saturdays of each month from 9:00 AM to 2:00 PM. Any enlisted officer who is below a certain rank (or any family member that they designate) is able to shop for free at the attic.

The Airmen's Attic is most in need of furniture, appliances and other household goods, but they will accept any of the following types of items:

- Furniture
- Electronics
- Office supplies
- Men's and Women's business and casual clothing
- Children's clothing
- Toys
- Bicycles and sports equipment
- Cash donations

Items can be donated by the public on the first and third Saturdays of the month anytime between 9:00 AM and 2:00 PM. You should bring the items to the Lightning Gate Visitor's Center, located on Litchfield Road between Glendale and Northern Avenues. You can then call the Airmen's Attic at 623-856-6415 and someone will meet you at the gate to receive your items. They will provide you a receipt for your donation.

I encourage everyone to donate your slightly used items to the Airman's Attic at Luke Air Force Base. It is a great way to give back to those men and women who dedicate their time to protecting our country.
