The Glendale Citizen's Police Academy is another opportunity for Glendale citizens to be active in our community. The Academy was developed to provide you with firsthand knowledge about our Police Department and how all of the different areas of the department operate.



The Citizen's Police Academy has been extremely popular and many of the participants have gone on to volunteer for the police department. As a member of the Glendale Citizen Police Academy, you will get to do some exciting things like participate in firearm training scenarios, shoot police weapons, drive police vehicles, go on a police ride along and watch K-9 trainings.



The Academy is offered three times per year and the next one will begin August 8 and run for 12 weeks. There are 30 spaces in the Academy and there are still some spots open. It is first come, first serve so apply today. If you apply and the spots are all full you will be placed on a waiting list for future academies.
