GLENDALE A TO Z DEBUTS ON CITY TV STATION

GLENDALE, Ariz. – Television viewers can sit in their living room and learn everything they need to know about the city of Glendale in a new TV show called “Glendale A to Z.” Produced by the staff of the city’s award winning television station, Glendale 11, the program covers numerous service-related topics from how to find a city park and rent a ramada to the do’s and don’ts of the city landfill.
